The NGOs had organized a program on Present Day Relevance of Holy Scripture Ramayana, Ramcharit Manas on Saturday, December 16, 2023. The speaker for the event was Dr.. Vedprakash Mishra, Hon. The four wars he mentioned were between Kaikeyi & Bharat, Hanuman and Lankini, Laxman's anguish during Setu bandhan, and Ram and Rawan.

He also mentioned about the symbolization of the three states, namely Janakpuri, Ayodhya, Lanka and the Setu. He also mentioned about the governance by consensus than majority, quoting the instances of Ram being sent to forest against the wishes of the subjects because there

was no consensus, as Kaikeyi and Manthara could have voted against Ram becoming the crown prince and subsequently Sita tyag, because a dhobi expressed doubt about the character of Queen Sita.





Program Schedule



A Report on Neuro-Linguistic Programming, NLP

A seminar on Neuro-Linguistic Programming, NLP was conducted on by Dr. Ashutosh A. Paturkar.

Objective of program: The objective of the seminar was to acquaint the teaching and non-teaching staff about the effective communication skills, class room engagement of students for better teaching learning experience.

During his presentation Dr. Paturkar mentioned about the origin of the NLP and its applications in all walks of life. He quoted J. Gaspari, that if people were honest, they would tell you that they do not feel consistently and adequately heard, known, understood and accepted. Thus it is important to be a good listener for a productive communication.

He also mentioned that NLP is primarily about communication skills. It is also about studying, understanding and

transferring the skills of successful people in any field. The purpose of NLP is to relate our words, thoughts and behaviour to our goals and objectives.

He insisted that the communication has to be assertive. He explained the point giving various examples from different walks of life how to make communication assertive. He also distinguished between the aggressive, submissive and assertive communication. He explained how the communication affects the quality of life positively or negatively depending upon the quality of communication.

He explained the Neurological Learning Levels as...

- Linvironmental: The surroundings and the other people we relate to
- ♣ Behaviour: Specific actions we carry out
- ♣ Beliefs & Values: What we believe and matter to us
- ♣ Identity: Our basic sense of self, core values and mission in life
- **♣** Spiritual: Conscious thoughts and emotions

He told about the NLP briefs as Originators: John Grinder- Linguist & Richard Bandler-Computer expert and a mathematician. Both studied the pattern how people get successful.

NLP uses these patterns to teach others to focus on how successful people excel. NLP bypasses why some people excel.

He then mentioned about how the Thinking Process get underway and Mental Strategies to deal with the situation. He mentioned that the Visual - see the world, Auditory - hear world and Kinesthetic - feel world. He gave multiple examples to understand who are visuals, auditory and kinesthetic and how to understand them. Finally he gave inputs on how to handle questions, what are the various types of question and how to identify a statement behind a question.

A Report on Meeting with the stakeholders

March 30, 2024

A meeting with the stakeholders was conducted on March 30, 2024. The meeting was addressed by Dr. Swar Gattani, a Procurement Specialist and Environment enthusiast.

The objective of the meeting was to identify areas where employment opportunities are higher and the topics not covered in the syllabus of the affiliated university.

Dr. Gattani suggested the following topics to be emphasized during the program. He pointed out that one of the neglected topics in the entire supply chain is the procurement. He suggested that if the syllabus can include details of procurement it will be beneficial to students. The topics like Purchase, Buy, Sourcing, Supply Chain Management, Strategic Sourcing, Negotiation, Spend Management, Vendor Evaluation / Analysis, Auctions etc.

He also highlighted process parameters like Requirement Analysis – What is required, application areas, Specifications, Location, Quantity, Payment Terms, Freight, Delivery Period, Warranty / Post Sales Support, Brand, Technical Comparisons / Evaluation etc. He also mentioned about what makes the topic interesting. The study of Understanding Supply Chain across domains – Multiple products, several companies, varied sales professionals, Buy many, Sell Few, Quote from many, order to a few, Technical Challenges, application areas, regional dynamics, post sales support, AMC / ARC / Open PO / Standing PO, Payment terms / Cycle and Every day a new challenge.

He also mentioned about the career opportunities in procurement like Procurements, Vendor Management, Identification, Evaluation, Onboarding, Maintain, Sourcing Item, vendor, exploring newer solutions, Item Management Consistency, specifications, etc., Compliance GST, Logistics, Procurement SOPs, Stock Management Setting Reorder Levels, Critical Stock Management, AMC ARC, Logistics Rail, Road, Air, Sea, Courier, Transport, Dedicated Vehicles, Part Loads, etc. and Payments.

He gave examples from multiple industries and the procurement specialists are required in these industries.

The meeting was attended by the Director, members of faculty, librarian and non-teaching staff.

A Report on Industry Interaction Meeting

A industry interaction meeting was held on March 30, 2024. The meeting was addressed by Mr. Prasad Phasate a prominent industrialist who recently diversified in new businesses.

The objective of the meeting was to acquaint the students with various opportunities and challenges an industrialist face.

Mr. Phasate initially highlighted his story mentioning about the family business and how the family business was not only facing competition but was also getting saturated in the new business landscape of online trading and marketing. He listed the rules of diversification and the due diligence that the entrepreneur must undertake before diversification. He mentioned that while diversifying he identified the business, the nature of businesses and how they will not face the same challenge that the family business was facing. He specifically mentioned about the paint business, he had diversified, as a business where the client interaction is more physical than online, the pre and the post sales service that has to be offered.

Mr. Phasate mentioned about the product development process in his company. He said even the product is not new to the market the approach towards product development has to be innovative. Offering multiple products helps the organization in addressing to various price points that the customer is looking forward to. He talked about the qulity of product and said that you have to source the best raw material for the premium products you are offering to the market, may be you have to import the raw material but do not hesitate to invest in getting the best raw material and ensuring manufacturing processes that gives the best finished product in the price category.

He pointed out that a start-up in the initial stages may turn out to be a training center for the established players but do not hire incompetent people who cannot communicate your product well to the customer. You need to train the sales force on a regular basis for better promotion of your product. He also mentioned about having products at multiple price points to address large and heterogenous target audience.

He suggested that in institutional sales you need to identify the gate keepers who influence the purchase decision. He suggested to respect all the gate keepers in the buying process to get the buy-in. The meeting was attended by the Director, members of faculty, librarian student and non-teaching staff.





A Report on Workshop of Blooms Taxonomy

9th Dec 2023

A workshop on Blooms Taxonomy was conducted on 9th Dec 2023 by Dr. Ashutosh A. Paturkar.

The objective of the seminar was to acquaint the teaching staff about the use of Blooms Taxonomy for framing questions for the mid semester and end semester examinations.

During his presentation Dr. Paturkar mentioned about the Blooms Taxonomy, hierarchical classification of the different levels of thinking, and how they are applied when creating course objectives. A statement of a learning objective contains a verb (an action) and an object (usually a noun).

The verb generally refers to [actions associated with] the intended cognitive process. The object generally describes the knowledge students are expected to acquire or construct.

The cognitive process dimension represents a continuum of increasing cognitive complexity—from remember to create.

Remember - Understand - Apply - Analyze - Evaluate - Create

The knowledge dimension represents a range from concrete (factual) to abstract (metacognitive). Representation of the knowledge dimension as a number of discrete steps can be a bit misleading. For example, all procedural knowledge may not be more abstract than all conceptual knowledge. And metacognitive knowledge is a special case. In this model, "metacognitive knowledge is knowledge of [one's own] cognition and about oneself in relation to various subject matters".

The Knowledge Dimension

Factual - Conceptual - Procedural - Metacognitive

He then demonstrated from the syllabus as to how to use the various action words in framing the questions. He said while framing the questions keep in mind what the students are expected to answer and then frame the questions using the action words appropriately.




