B. Objectives of the Anti-Ragging Cell

1. To ensure strict compliance with UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations.
2. To prevent and prohibit any form of ragging within the campus, hostels, or academic premises.
3. To create awareness among students through orientation programs, notices, and campaigns.
4. To monitor and address issues related to student safety and discipline.
5. To receive and promptly act upon complaints of ragging.
6. To maintain records of undertakings submitted by students and parents.
7. To forward serious cases to police authorities whenever required.

C. Functions of the Anti-Ragging Cell

- Conduct regular meetings and campus inspections.
- Display anti-ragging information boards at prominent locations.
- Establish helpline numbers and grievance redressal mechanisms.
- Ensure anonymous complaint mechanisms.
- Take disciplinary action as per UGC and University guidelines.
