

## Facility for Differently Abled Students

Orange City Institute of Management is committed to creating an inclusive and barrier-free learning environment for students with disabilities. In line with the guidelines of UGC, AICTE, Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act 2016, and RTM Nagpur University norms, the institution provides supportive facilities to ensure equal access to academic and co-curricular opportunities.

### 1. Physical Infrastructure Support

- Ramp Access: Ramps installed at key entry and exit points for smooth wheelchair movement.
- Handrails & Support Bars: Provided along staircases and corridors.
- Accessible Classrooms: Wide doors, adequate circulation space, and adjustable seating arrangements.
- Ground Floor Access: Essential offices, classrooms, and administrative blocks are accessible at ground level.

### 2. Assistive and Learning Support

- Writer/Scribe Facility: Provided during examinations as per university guidelines.
- Extra Time for Exams: Students with certified disabilities are given compensatory time.
- Accessible Learning Materials: Notes, presentations, and reading materials provided in soft copy on request.
- Mentorship Support: Faculty mentors assigned to assist differently-abled students academically.

### 3. Administrative & Welfare Support

- Dedicated Nodal Officer: A faculty coordinator (Prof. Robin Ukey) assists differently-abled students in accessing available facilities and support systems.
- Priority Counters: Students with disabilities receive priority in admission, fee payment, library, and administrative services.
- Scholarship Guidance: Assistance in applying for Government of India disability scholarships.

### 4. Safety and Support Services

- Emergency Assistance: Support staff available to assist differently-abled students in case of emergencies.
- First Aid Facility: Basic medical support available on campus.

### 5. Institutional Commitment

The institute is committed to further enhancing accessibility and ensuring that differently-abled students participate fully in all academic, co-curricular, and placement activities without discrimination.
