

Health Facility at Orange City Institute of Management (OCIM)

Orange City Institute of Management (OCIM) is committed to ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of all its students, faculty members, and staff. The institute provides essential health facilities on campus to promote a safe and supportive learning environment.

1. First-Aid & Basic Medical Support

- The campus is equipped with a **First-Aid Room** containing essential medical supplies such as bandages, antiseptics, pain relievers, and emergency kits.
- A **designated first-aid in-charge** (Dr. Jayshri Kapse) ensures timely assistance during minor injuries or health concerns.

2. Trained Health Support Staff

- A **trained nurse/first-aid professional** is available during working hours to assist with medical emergencies in the vicinity of the college.
- Faculty and administrative staff are oriented in basic first-aid response for immediate support.

3. Tie-up with Nearby Hospitals

For advanced medical support, OCIM maintains formal tie-ups with nearby hospitals and clinics, ensuring quick access to professional medical care. Examples include:

- Primary Health Center, Rui
- Private clinics and diagnostic centers within 3–5 km of campus

Ambulance facilities from partner hospitals can be availed in case of emergency.

4. Emergency Response System

- Emergency contact numbers are displayed prominently on campus.
- Quick-response protocols are established for managing injuries, illnesses, and accidents.
- The campus is equipped with fire and safety measures, including extinguishers and evacuation plans.

5. Health Awareness & Wellness Initiatives

OCIM regularly conducts:

- Health check-up camps
- Blood donation drives
- Mental health awareness workshops
- Yoga and wellness sessions
- Sessions on hygiene, nutrition, lifestyle management

These initiatives encourage students to adopt a healthy and balanced lifestyle.

6. Clean & Hygienic Campus Environment

- The campus is maintained with high standards of cleanliness.
- Regular sanitation of classrooms, washrooms, and common areas.
- Safe drinking water available through RO purification systems.
