

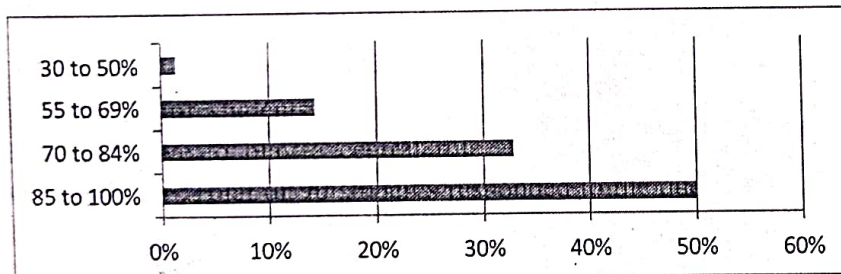


Institutional Performance Feedback Report Academic year 2021-2022

30 to 50%	1.43%

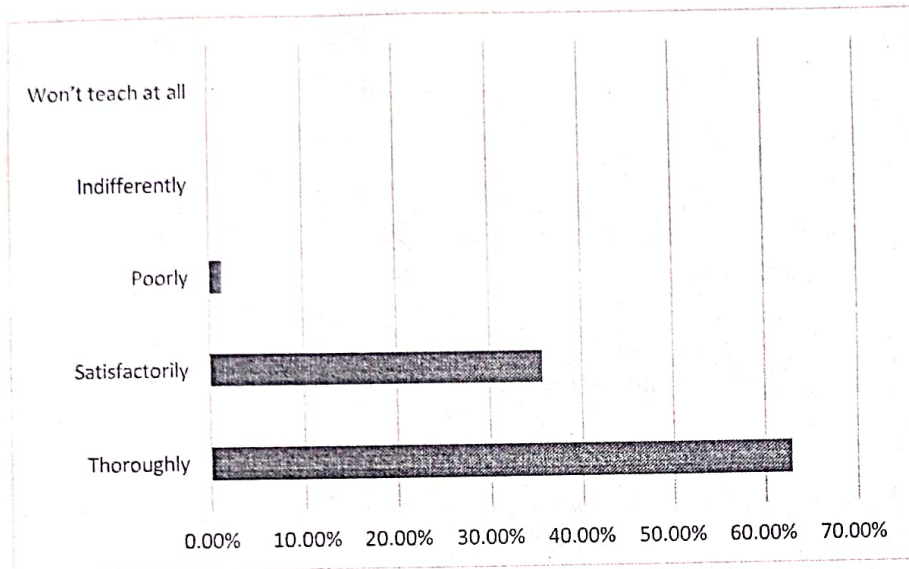

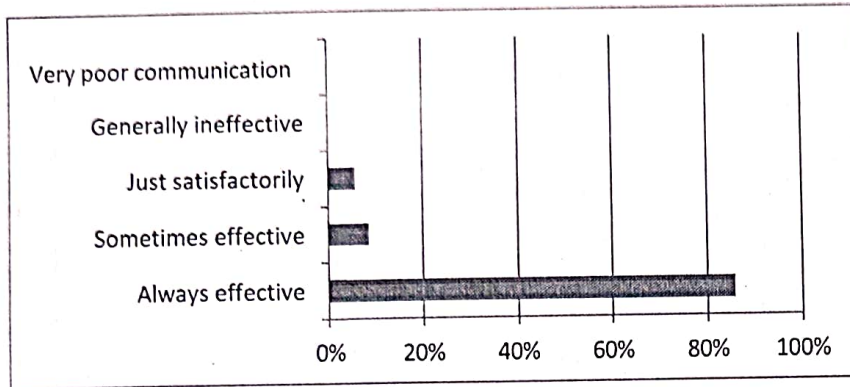


Students responded about the preparation of teachers before the class, 35% had a view “Thoroughly” and whopping 63% satisfactorily.

Very poor communication	0.00%

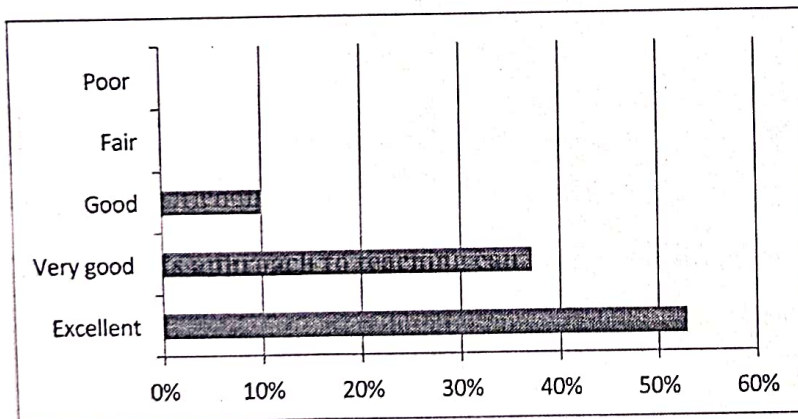

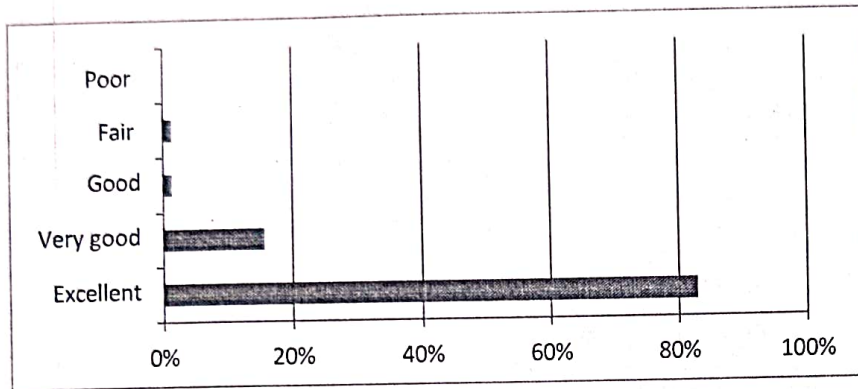

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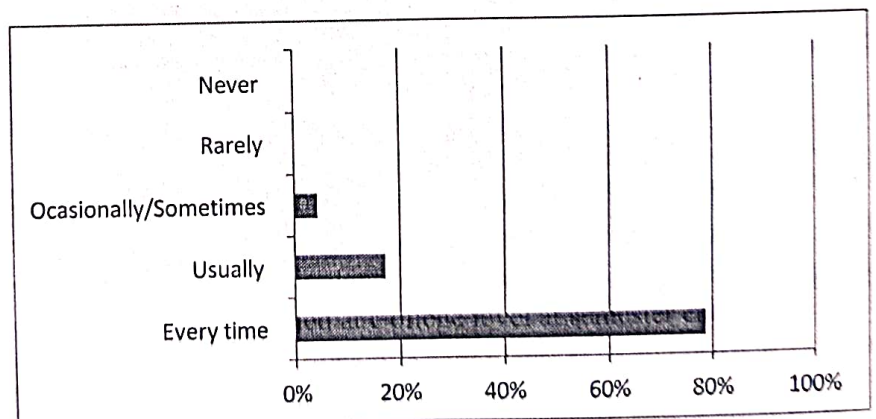

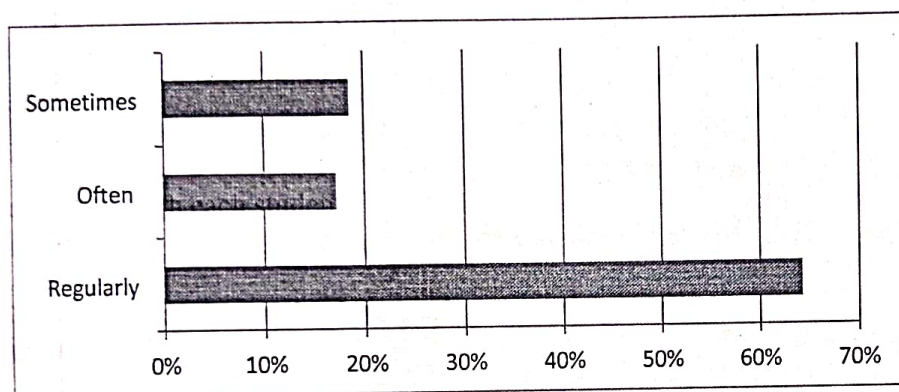

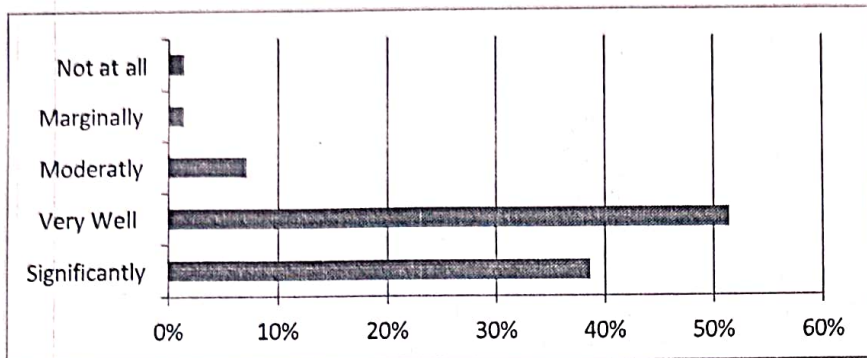

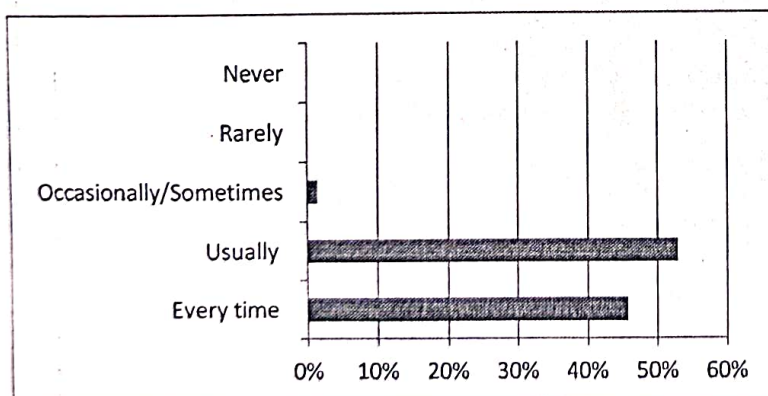

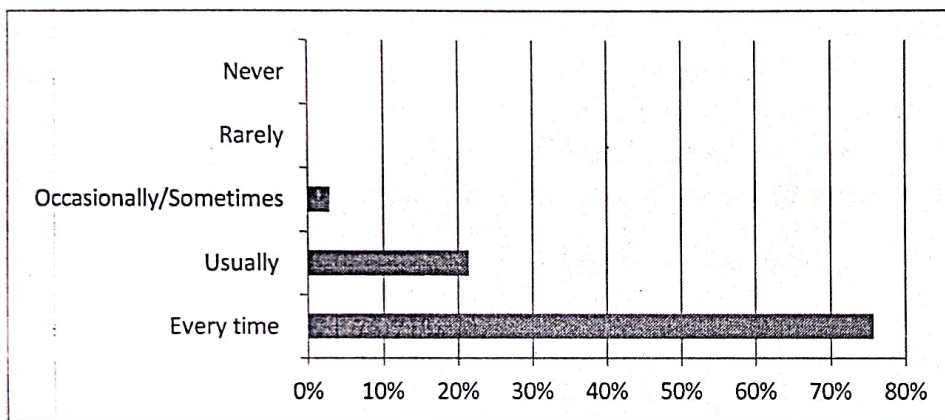

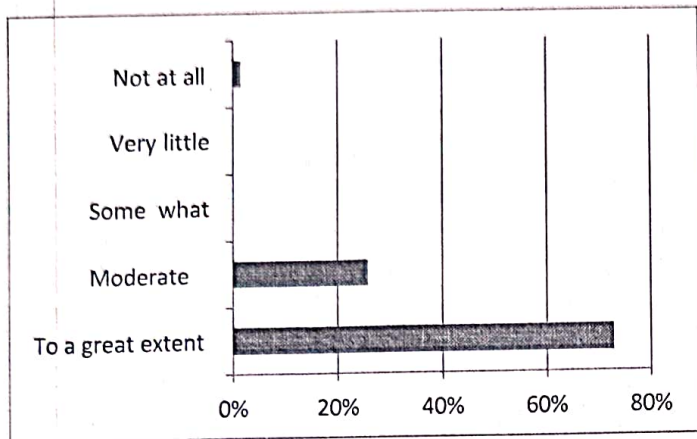

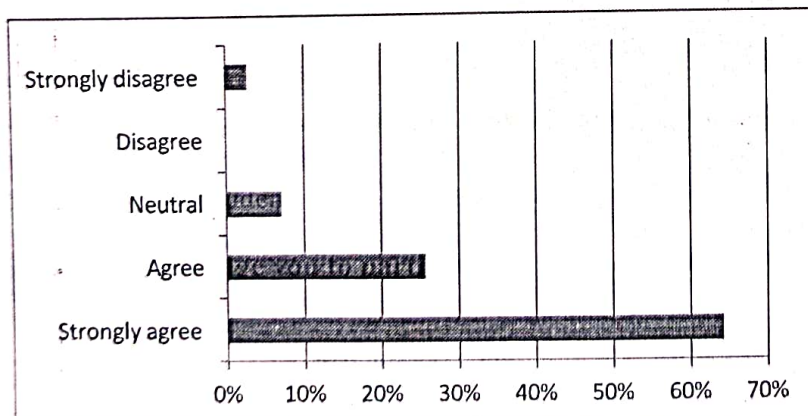

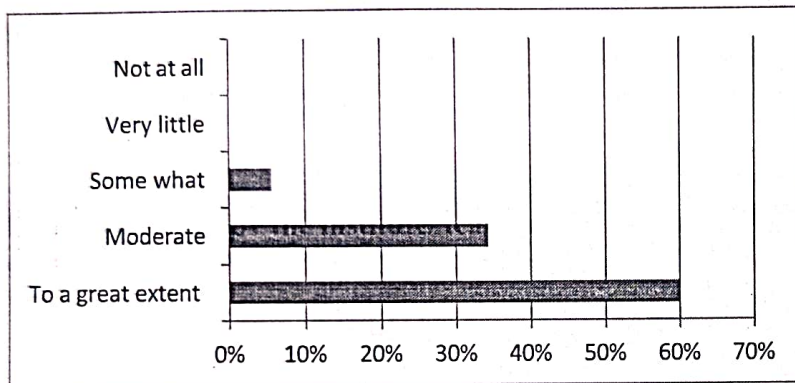

Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

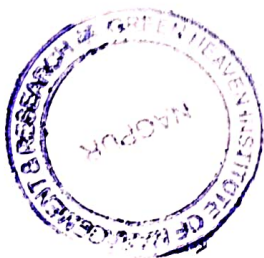

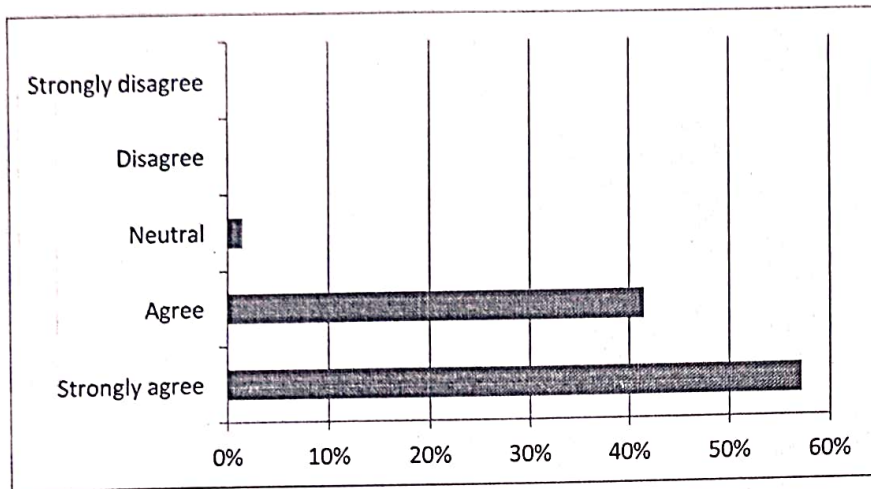
