2. Objectives of the Incubation Center

1. To encourage entrepreneurship and innovation among students.
2. To identify, mentor, and develop innovative ideas into viable business models.
3. To provide support through training, workshops, expert talks, and startup exposure.
4. To foster industry–academia collaboration for startup development.
5. To support pre-incubation and incubation activities for budding entrepreneurs.

3. Functions of the Incubation Center

1. Conduct entrepreneurship awareness camps and innovation-related workshops.
2. Guide students in developing business plans, market strategies, and feasibility analysis.

3. Facilitate access to mentors, industry experts, and startup facilitators.
4. Provide resources such as workspace, internet, library support, and basic infrastructure.
5. Identify potential startups and support them through pre-incubation programs.
6. Help connect student startups to Government/Private incubation schemes.
7. Organize competitions like B-Plan, Idea Innovation Challenge, Prototype Showcases, etc.
8. Maintain records of activities, participants, and outcomes for reporting and accreditation.

The committee shall remain active for the academic period **2024–Onwards** and may be revised by the institution as required.
